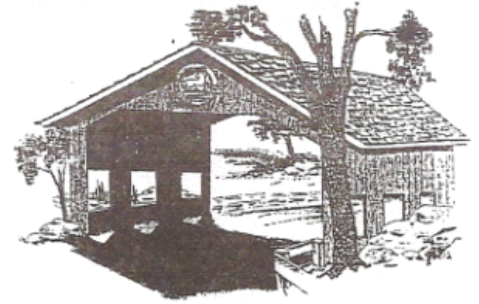

The Stallion Springs Community Services District and the Stallion Springs Police Department is excited to enhance our partnership with Nixle. This Nixle platform has been tested and has proven to be an effective communication tool for residents during local emergencies.

What is Nixle?

Nixle is a free, simple and secure service provided by the Stallion Springs Community Services District and Police Department to provide notifications to registered users regarding emergencies that the Stallion Springs Community Services District is experiencing, as well as upcoming local events. Nixle notifies registered users over their cell phones via text messages, through e-mails and via Internet access. Your account can be customized so you receive the information that matters most to you.

Here are some types of notifications that you may receive, but are not limited to the following:

- Traffic related incidents
 - Road Closures
 - Weather emergencies
 - Earthquakes, Floods, Snow Emergencies
 - Fire in your area that could put you at risk
 - Evacuations
 - Public Safety Power Shut Offs
 - Drinking water contamination or boil water notice
 - Criminal Activity
 - Missing Persons
 - Any emergency reason deemed necessary by city/county officials.
 - Miscellaneous Community Events
- Again registration is **FREE, SIMPLE, and SECURE.**

If you are, here are some directions on how to get signed up.

1. Text your ZIPCODE to 888777 from your mobile phone. Once registered, a confirmation text will be sent back to you.

2. Or you can visit www.nixle.com to create a user profile and customize alert settings.

When citizens receive information from our agency via Nixle, you know it can be trusted and that the information is coming straight from the source. I invite and strongly encourage all residents of the Stallion Springs Community Services District to sign up for this service. Let's get informed and sign up for Nixle now.

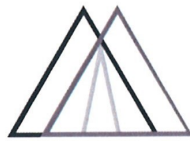

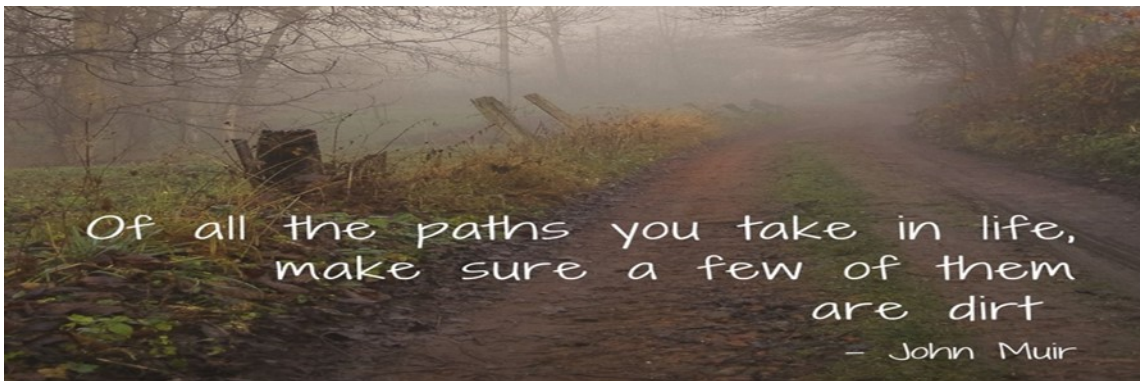

JUST A HEADS UP ABOUT WATER PAYMENTS.....

When you use your bill payment system to pay Stallion Springs CSD, your bank writes a check and it is sent by mail.

Your bank may take money out of your account today, but not write a check for up to 10 days after your request.

We may not get your payment for up to 14 days after your request.

SSCSD offers credit card payments thru our website www.stallionspringscsd.com and we now offer Phone payments and Auto payments by calling: 661-825-1515.

There is a minimum processing charge for the online credit card payments, but the payments are processed immediately.

PAY ONLINE! Pay your water bill anytime, anywhere. Online Bill Pay makes it easy for you to manage your water bill. You can view your bill, see payment history, etc. You can even do auto pay. Owners can register or use Quick Pay. **Renter's Only use Quick Pay.** Go to our website at www.stallionspringscsd.com. It is located on the Home Page.

Please be advised that the Main District Water Valve should never be turned at your meter. By doing this, it may cause damage or may be broken which will cause water shut offs not only to your residence, but to a whole neighborhood. Thank you.

Recommended: All customers should have their own customer valve for shutting off water.

INFORMATION AND NOTES

- ◆ For emergency police, fire and medical calls dial 911 and specify to the dispatcher that you live in Stallion Springs. To reach the police for non-emergency purposes, contact Kern County Dispatch at (800) or (661) 861-3110.
- ◆ California law states that dogs must be on a leash. Please follow this rule. Stallion Springs Police will be working with Kern County Animal Control in regard to ticketing violators.
- ◆ For District emergencies off hours, such as a main line water break you may call 822-3268. Leave a message with the problem, your name and contact number and an on-call District staff will be paged.
